

INTER-STATE GANG OF GANJA SUPPLIERS BUSTED

21.44 Kgs GANJA WORTH LAKHS OF RUPEES SEIZED

It was highlighted in the news that the student/ younger group are indulging in consumption of drugs like ganja etc. In this regard, Hon. DIGP Shri. Brijesh Kumar Singh had issued strict instruction to nab the persons involved in the illegal supply of drugs/ Ganja. Under the close supervision of SP DNH Shri. Sharad Darade and SDPO Shri. Manasvi Jain a team was formed to watch over the said illegal activities.

Today on receiving secret information that one lady namely Sushila Lasal Chetiyaar r/o. Bulsar (Gujarat) & others are having illegal stock of "Ganja" and they are coming to Silvassa in one Auto Rickshaw to sell it. The said information was brought into the notice of Superior officer. After obtaining legal permission a team consisting PI Shri K. B. Mahajan, PI/SHO, Lady PSI Chhaya Tandel, ASI Bhasker Patil, HC Bharat Rohit, PC Nilay Rathore, PC Prasant Rathore & PC Zuber Khatik of Silvassa Police Station went to Amlī-Hanuman Temple road near Alpha Packaging. In after noon one suspected auto Rickshaw bearing registration No. GJ-15/YY-6953 was stopped near Alpha packaging company. On searching the said Auto by Lady Officer two ladies and two gents were found. They identified themselves as (1) Sushila Chetiyaar, aged 32 years r/o. Bulsar (2) Tehmina Mehboob Ghanchi aged-28 r/o. Khar Abrama Teh. Jalalpur, Dist. Navsari Gujarat (3) Manish Parshnath Dubey (Auto driver) aged-29 years r/o. Shethiya nagar, Sai Darshan Apartment Valsad (Gujarat) and one Juvenile. On searching the Auto two bags containing 10 packets ""Ganja"" was found, on weighting it was **21.44 Kgs** worth of Rs. **1,68,352/-** the said Ganga and Auto Rickshaw worth of Rs. 50,000/- has been seized. In this regard an FIR No. No.05/2018 u/s 8 (a)(c) & 20 (ii) (C) of N.D.P.S. Act, 1985 has been registered at Silvassa Police Station. The above three accused have been arrested. A team has been sent to Gujarat to carryout search of the residence of the arrested accused. Primary investigation reveals that the source of Ganja is from Orissa State. Further investigation is in progress.
