

PRESS NOTE

The Student Police Cadet (SPC) programme was successfully launched by Hon'ble Union Home Minister Shri Rajnath Singh on 21st July, 2018 at Tau Devi Lal Stadium, Medicity, Islampur Colony, Sector 28, Gurugram, Haryana. In the said occasion Hon'ble Chief Minister of Haryana and other dignitaries were also present.

In the said Student Police Cadet (SPC) programme, all States and Union Territories were invited to attend the programme alongwith school students. In this regard, a team consisting of 24 members including one Police Inspector Shri N. L. Rohit, Drill Instructor Shri Jignesh B. Valand, IRBn Ct., two Physical Education Teachers named Bhavik Patel and Manesh Patel and 20 students from the UTs of Daman & Diu and Dadra & Nagar Haveli (10 student each territory).

The following objectives of the said Student Police Cadet (SPC) programme are as under:-

- ii) To appraise students about various community policing initiatives.
- iii) To sensitize the students and make them aware safety of women and children.
- iv) To make a bridge between police and community.
