➤ One Arrested in Threatening cum Extortion call

Shri Viral Ashokkumar Shah of Village Dadra gave a complaint at Silvassa Police Station on 06/03/2018 alleging that, at about 14.57 hrs. he received threatening call from unknown mobile number. The caller threatened him to pay Rs. 5,00,000 (Five Lacs) and if he informs the police then they will face severe consequences. Therefore, FIR No. 64/2018 u/s 387 of IPC was registered at Silvassa Police Station.

Looking into the seriousness of the case, under the direction of Hon'ble Dy. Insp. Gen. of Police, a team was constituted under the supervision of the Superintendent of Police Shri. Sharad Darade, IPS and Shri Manasvi Jain, Sub – Divisional Police Officer. On the basis of electronic surveillance, police team headed by Shri. K. B. Mahajan, PI, SHO, Silvassa, Shri A. A. Dias, PSI, Crime Branch, Shri. B. V. Patil, ASI, Shri Rithin Kuriakose, SI, Shri A. R. Ahir, HC, Shri. Prakash Mane, PC, Shri Jitu Gavit, PC, was formed and proceeded to Surat of Gujarat and Sakri of Maharashtra.

After, thorough investigation and analysis on 08/03/2018, the team was able to nab one accused Mr. Arun Tilaksinh Chauvan from Village Kadare, of Taluka Sakri, Maharashtra. On interrogation he confessed about his involvement alongwith one other accused. He was produced before the Hon'ble Court and 5 days Police Custody has been granted. The efforts are being made to know the motive behind the crime and to arrest the other accused.
