

**ANNUAL PRESS RELEASE 2017**  
**OF POLICE DEPARTMENT DADRA AND NAGAR HAVELI**

**CRIME DETAILS**

- Heinous crime has decreased in the UT of DNH. Heinous crime was **11.00%** of total crime in year 2017 whereas it was **13.61%** in year 2016.
- Total **310** cases have been registered in the UT of Dadra and Nagar Haveli in the year 2017. Out of which **239** cases were registered at Silvassa Police Station and **71** cases were registered at Khanvel Police Station.
- Total **34** heinous cases, **243** non-heinous cases and **33** under Special Local Laws have been registered.
- Out of these, **200** cases have been detected/traced which is **64.72%**.
- DNH Police has cracked down heavily on illegal liquor transportation. **10 Excise Cases were registered** in the UT, out of which 08 cases have been worked out and total liquor amounting Rs. 32,28,706/- was seized. In total, 10 accused were arrested and 12 vehicles have been seized in above cases till now.
- Increase in overall registration of cases is due to stringent action by police under Excise Act, Cruelty on Animal Act, I.T. Act etc.

**POLICE ACTION IN NOTABLE CRIMES:-**

- A kidnapping for Ransom case vide F.I.R. No. 11/2017 was registered at Silvassa Police Station regarding kidnap of 26 years old son of an Industrialist. DNH Police recovered the victim safely and was also successful in arresting the 07 culprits.
- An F.I.R. No. 179/2017 was registered alleging loot of victim's laptop, mobile and belongings by a gang in the auto rickshaw. Dadra and Nagar Haveli Police was successful in busting the family gang and 06 accused were arrested along with Recovery of Laptop and Samsung J5 mobile.
- An F.I.R. No. 140/2017 was registered at Silvassa Police Station regarding burglary at a mobile shop and theft of 83 mobiles with value of Rs. 9,43,179/-. Possible efforts were made & as a result 01

accused was arrested along with recovery of 54 mobiles Amounting Rs. 7,89,230/-.

- An F.I.R. No. 166/2017 was registered at Silvassa Police Station regarding theft of 06 Amplifiers, 06 Speakers, 01 Computer and other accessories in Dadra Garden Musical Fountain amounting Rs. 3,33,000/-. All possible efforts were made as a result 03 accused were arrested with 100% recovery.
- An FIR No. 47/2017 u/s. 407 of IPC was lodged at Khanvel Police Station regarding missing of a Truck No. DN-09-J-9300 carrying PTY Yarn of 739 Cartoons amounting Rs. 27,05,887/- from Sanathan Textile Pvt. Ltd, Surangi for delivery at Adani Hazira Port, Surat. During the course of investigation, the said Truck was recovered Empty from Hotel Supreme, Ankleshwar & major recovery of PTY Yarn of value Rs. 23,00,000/- was made from Surat, Gujarat. Yarn theft nexus has been busted with arrest of 03 accused.
- In a sensational case F.I.R. No. 185/2014 related to rape & murder of 14 years old girl, the accused Nitin Ramesh Prajapati was proved guilty and was convicted and sentenced Life Imprisonment in the year 2017. This was a result of scientific evidence gathering and regular follow up of the case to ensure conviction. Two life imprisonments to run consequently.

#### **TRAFFIC UNIT:-**

Total **49,433 Traffic Challans** were challaned and total **fine of amount of Rs 1,29,25,140/-** was collected by Traffic Unit, Dadra and Nagar Haveli for the year, 2017 as compared to **Rs 1,17,86,740/-** in 2016 which is an increase of 9.65 % fine than previous year.

#### **VVIP BANDOFAST/PM VISIT:-**

Shri Narendra Modi, Hon'ble Prime Minister of India visited UT Dadra and Nagar Haveli on 17th April, 2017 and held a public meeting at Silvassa. Huge crowd/supporters i.e. more than one lakh people had gathered at the venue. In order to maintain law and order during the programme, Police staff from Daman-Diu, alongwith a team of

Paramilitary Force and Gujarat State Reserve Force were called for assistance and as a result no untoward incident took place.

#### **PASSPORT POLICE VERIFICATION:-**

- DNH is the first UT to adopt mPassport app which is based on GPS based address verification mechanism
- In the year 2017, 2296 applications were despatched to Regional Passport Office Mumbai for Passport purpose as compared to 1532 applications in 2016 which is an increase of 49.86 %

#### **MODERNIZATION:-**

- A new IT CELL has been constituted to deal with cases related to cybercrime, analysis of call details, CAFs, etc.
- CAW Cell has been established in the UT of Dadra and Nagar Haveli at Pipariya Out Post to deal the with cases related to violence/crime against woman.
- The Police Department of Dadra and Nagar Haveli have installed total 33 GPS System in all vehicle of the department.
- District Forensic Mobile Vans have been used by DNH Police for obtaining forensic reports during criminal investigations. DFMU is helpful to the investigating officers in gathering forensic evidence from the site.
- CCTNS has been adopted fully and all data is being digitized on real-time basis. FIRs are also uploaded on website for viewing of Public.

#### **RECRUITMENT & PROMOTIONS:-**

- In the year 2017, 06 Recruit Police Sub Inspectors and 67 Recruit Police Constables have completed their training successfully and have joined Dadra and Nagar Haveli Police.
- 02 Police Sub Inspectors were promoted to Police Inspector under Special Grade Designation on 02.03.2017.
- 22 Police Head Constables were promoted to Assistant Sub Inspector under Special Grade Designation on 23.05.2017.

- 38 Police Constables were promoted to Police Head Constables under Special Grade Designation on 26.05.2017.

### **TRAINING AND SKILL DEVELOPMENT:-**

- On the directions by DIGP, DD&DNH, weekly Physical Training (P.T.) and Parade are being held to keep the police personnel physically fit.
- 14 Police Personnel of Dadra and Nagar Haveli Police were sent at Karai, Gujarat for 03 months “Commando Training” course from 19 June 2017.
- 10 Police Personnel of Dadra and Nagar Haveli Police were sent for one week specialized training course in Forensic Science Laboratory (FSL) at Gandhinagar, Gujarat from 15<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> May 2017.
- 10 Police Personnel of Dadra and Nagar Haveli have undergone 02 weeks Personal Security Officer training at Police Training School, Saily.
- A Regular residential 04 Week Refresher Training Courses has been imparted to every Police Personnel of Dadra and Nagar Haveli at Police Training School, Saily.
- HDFC Bank carried out Cyber Crime Responder Training Workshop for Law Enforcement Officers on 15<sup>th</sup> November, 2017 at Police Head Quarters, Dadra and Nagar Haveli, Silvassa.

### **COMMUNITY POLICING:-**

- School Children of various schools were invited for Police Station/Thana visit and were imparted knowledge regarding functioning of Police Stations
- Recently, a Traffic Awareness Program was held on 13/12/2017 at Father Agnelo School Silvassa by I/c. Traffic along with two P.S.I. from Traffic Branch Delhi.
- Dadra and Nagar Haveli Police participated in the Career and Mela organized at Rakholi, Govt. School by Education Department on 21/12/2017 and imparted the knowledge regarding rules and regulations, Bomb Disposal Squad (BDS), Security gadgets to the

students. Quiz competition for children was also conducted by the traffic police and winners of the competition were awarded with gifts.

- Police Department of Dadra and Nagar Haveli observed 28<sup>th</sup> National Road Safety Week from 09.01.2017 to 15.01.2017 with true spirit. Many programmes were organized to create awareness among general public, school children, drivers etc. regarding road safety rules. Around 200 children from Govt. and Private Schools participated in the Drawing Competition on Road Safety Rules and were awarded with trophies and certificates for best performances by Hon'ble Administrator, Daman-Diu & Dadra and Nagar Haveli.
- A meeting with organizers of Navratri Mandals, AnandMela, Ganesh Mandals etc. of Dadra and Nagar Haveli are held regularly to convey the important instructions regarding law and order during the celebration.
- A meeting with the School officials, bus & vehicle operators was held before the start of new session regarding Bus facilities to students and Summer Camp.

#### **STAFF WELFARE:-**

- A meeting with all Police Personnel of Dadra and Nagar Haveli was held on 08/12/2017 at 15.00 hrs at Police Head Quarters, Silvassa. Modification of name of society was done and new Managing Committee and Executive committee has been formed.
